- 1 The name of the society is WildResearch Society
- 2 The purposes of the society are:
 - a) To protect the environment for the benefit of the public by conserving flora and fauna in British Columbia through related monitoring, research, training, and awareness programs.
 - b) To advance education by providing the public with training in environmental conservation, including bird banding and identification workshops, bird and butterfly monitoring and surveys, ecological restoration, and guided field trips; and by providing biologists with technical skills training in writing field-specific resumes and grant proposals, and administering projects.
 - c) To undertake activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment of the above charitable purposes.
